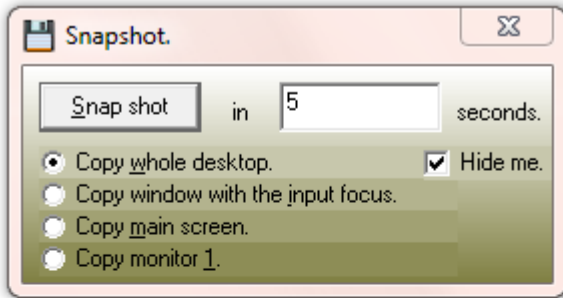


# Snapshot help and information file.

Version 0.00.0002 (27/08/2010), by Mark A. Agius.



Use **Snapshot** to copy, save or printout the screen or selected window image when you can't use the **Print Screen** key.

Click on **Snap shot** and after a short delay the screen or window image will be copied, saved or printed out.

This application uses a delay to copy/save/printout the image. So you can open menus and capture them in the image when pressing a key to save the image would close any open menus.

## How to use this application.

When you load **Snapshot.exe** you will see the above window.

Enter the time delay between **1** second and **86,400** seconds (1 day)

If you are copying the whole desktop and don't want to also copy the **Snapshot** window then tick the **Hide me** option.

If you want to copy everything, select **Copy whole desktop**.

If you want to only copy the selected window, then select **Copy window with the input focus**.

(If no window has the input focus, then the whole desktop is copied or saved)

If you want to copy the main monitor image only, select **Copy main screen**.

(This is the monitor with the taskbar)

If you only have one monitor then this is the same as the **Copy whole desktop** option.

If you want to only copy monitor 1 then select **Copy monitor 1**.

This is normally the same as the main screen.

If you want to only copy monitor 2 then select **Copy monitor 2**. (You must have two or more displays)

If you want to only copy monitor 3 then select **Copy monitor 3**. (You must have 3 or more displays)

' ' ' ' ' ' ' ' ' ' (Repeated up to your last monitor)

Then click on **Snap shot** to start the timer and copy the image to the clipboard.

By default this program copies the image to the clipboard.

If you want to copy the image and not save or print it, then tick the **Copy image to clipboard** menu option.

If you want to save or print the image, then tick **Save image to file...** or **Print snapshot image** menu option.

When you tick **Copy image...**, **Save image...** or **Print image...** other menu options will be added or removed.

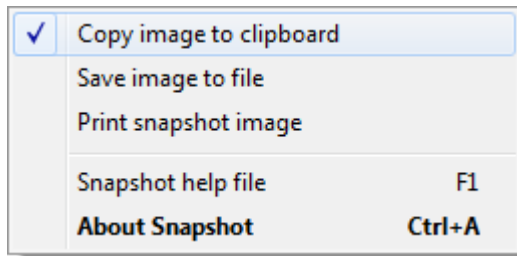
Eg.

Save image adds; **U**ser image filename, **A**uto image filename, **E**dit/display saved image.

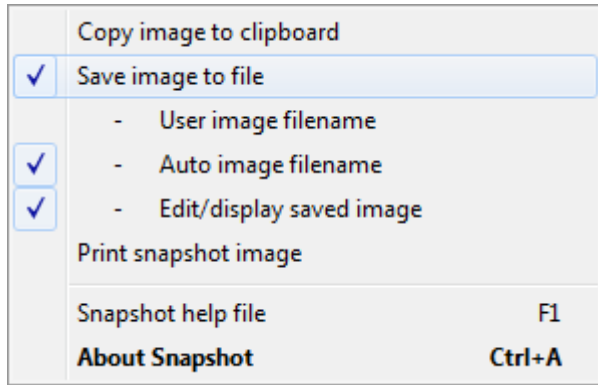
Printout image adds; **P**rint image with **t**itle.

**Click menu over the main window to display the menu.**

Click on **Copy image to clipboard** to tick this option. (Images will now be copied to your clipboard)



Click on **Save image to file...** to tick this option. (Images will now be saved in a file)



Click/Tick on **U**ser image filename to set your snapshot image file name location and file type.

Tick on **A**uto image filename to let Snapshot automatically create a file name based on the date and time.

Tick **E**dit/display saved image to open your image editing software when an image is saved.

Eg. Microsoft Paint, Microsoft Photo Editor etc. etc.

Depending on your default image software, not all file types will be loaded.

Try saving in different format if some don't work.

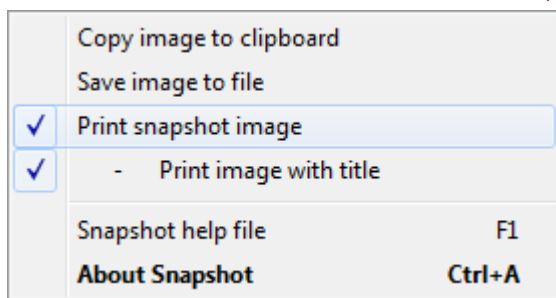
To change image format, click on **U**ser image file and select a different format.

Then tick **A**uto image filename again if you want a new file for every snapshot.

Click on **P**rint snapshot image to tick this option. (Images will now be printed out)

Although you can print out the image when it is captures, I would recommend you loading or pasting it with your image editing software.

You can then see what it looks like and edit it, before printing it out.



Tick **P**rint image with title to also print the image title at the top of the printout.

The printer title text can be:

Printout of whole desktop. :: Landscape, 3,324 x 1,0985 :: HP Deskjet F4200 series  
Printout of active window. :: Portrait, 402 x 568 :: HP Deskjet F4200 series  
Printout of main screen. :: Landscape, 1,662 x 1,0985 :: HP Deskjet F4200 series  
Printout of monitor 1 :: Landscape, 1,662 x 1,0985 :: HP Deskjet F4200 series

Press **F1** or click on **S**nAPSHOT **h**elp file to load and display this file.

Press **Ctrl+A** or click on **A**bout Snapshot to display the version information window.

### Supported image file types are:

<b>.BMP</b>	Bitmap Format.	(* .bmp)	(Default file type)
<b>.GIF</b>	Graphics Interchange Format.	(* .gif)	
<b>.JPEG</b>	JPEG File Interchange Format.	(* .jpg, *.jpeg, *.jpe)	
<b>.PNG</b>	Portable Network Graphics.	(* .png)	

### Version history:

#### **Version 0.00.0000** (25/08/2010 - 8:00pm bst)

First version.

Can set the time to any value. Even silly values less than zero seconds or over a few days can be entered.

Can copy the image only. Can't save or print image.

Can capture the whole desktop, the main monitor or any other monitor.

You can not capture a selected window with this version.

#### **Version 0.00.0001** (26/08/2010 - 1:00pm bst)

Can set the timer from 1 to seconds.

Can copy the image to the clipboard, save the image or print it out.

You can also capture the selected window.

The about box has a coloured background.

#### **Version 0.00.0002** (27/08/2010 – 10:00pm bst)

This is the same as version 0.00.0001 except the printer dialog box now selects the printer drive.

You can save the image using your file name as before or let Snapshot automatically create one using the current date and time.

You can turn off the printout title text above snapshot image if you wish.
